Recently, Congress passed, and President Trump signed into law, the **Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES)**, a \$2 trillion stimulus bill, "to blunt the impact of an economic downturn set in motion by the Covid pandemic." This acknowledgement by Congress that the work of nonprofit organizations such as hospitals and churches is essential, will benefit both the donor and the charitable organization as it helps to build back up the depressed economy. Part of the CARES Act refers to charitable donations made by individuals to qualified nonprofit organizations, such as churches.

For taxpayers who do not itemize their deductions and take the standard deduction, there will be an "above the line" additional deduction allowed based upon the donations actually made to a charitable organization between January 1, 2020 and December 31, 2020. For single filers, the deduction is limited to \$300 and for married couples filing jointly, it is limited to \$600. Again, the deduction is only allowed if the single filer actually makes a \$300 or greater donation to a charitable organization and for married couples, a \$600 or greater donation. This additional deduction will reduce a filer's adjusted gross income thereby, reducing their taxable income.

For taxpayers who itemize their deductions, the cap on the allowable deduction for charitable donations will be increased from 60% of adjusted gross income to 100%.

For both situations cited above it is important to understand that this deduction IS NOT A TAX CREDIT; in other words, it does not reduce your taxes directly, only your taxable income. The ultimate effect on the amount of taxes you pay for 2020 will be based upon your tax bracket.

In view of this new information regarding charitable donations, please prayerfully consider supporting Immaculate Conception & Assumption of Our Lady during this difficult economic situation. Doing so will enable us to continue to minister to the spiritual needs of our community through our digital media efforts and by continuing to support our staff and facility needs. We recommend that you speak with a financial adviser before making any financial decisions regarding the CARES Act.
