**KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS PANCAKE BREAKFAST**

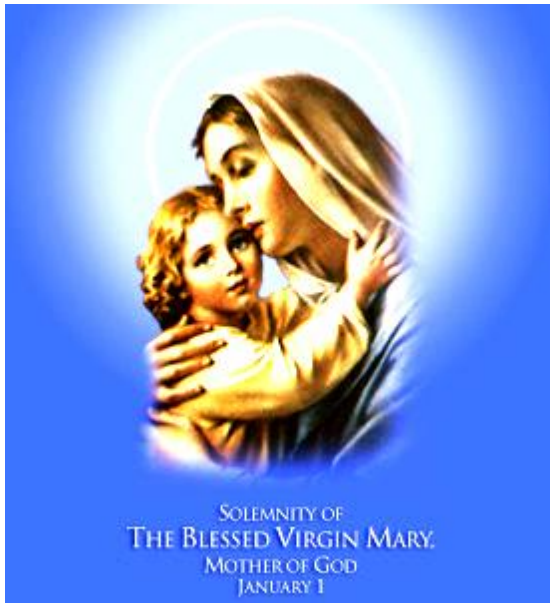
