The sanctuary candle at **St. Joseph** is burning in loving memory of **Thomas Schenk**, requested by **his mother Arleen.**



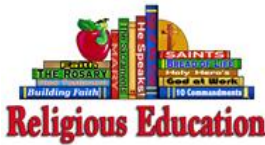
