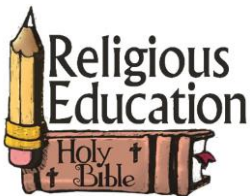

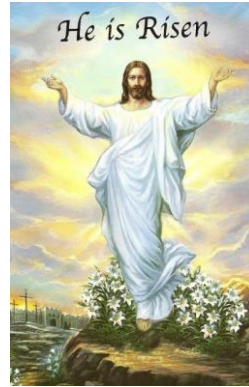
### 2019 ANNUAL HOLY NAME SCHOLARSHIP AWARD
