SECOND COLLECTION NEXT WEEKEND

Dear Friends in the Lord:

It is time again for our annual special offering for the *Church in Latin America*. Although the people are faith-filled, the needs in this region are great – and often seem insurmountable. The distance between rural areas and deteriorated roads make it difficult for some communities to have Mass celebrated regularly. Language barriers can make catechetical materials difficult to produce. We are called to share our faith with all, and next weekend's collection is a prophetic and bold way to do it.

For the past fifty years, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has helped 25 countries in Central and South America to confront challenges to the faith. With the support of all the Catholic faithful, we have funded activities that promote an encounter with Jesus Christ so that the faithful can become disciples.

On the very same weekend, June 15 & 16, we are also conducting the *Catholic Home Missions Appeal*. The Church has great needs around the world and the United States is no exception. Many dioceses here at home face challenges due to priest shortages, lack of funds, remote geography, or impoverished parishes. Forty-two percent of all diocese in the USA receive Catholic Home Mission support for evangelization, catechesis, ministry formation, and other areas of faith development. Your support of this collection will help our neighbors strengthen the Church at home to continue to provide essential pastoral outreach in home mission dioceses.

I am counting on your usual generosity again this year. Your support for each of these collections is vital. When you contribute, you become an instrument of peace and join with other Catholics in solidarity with the needy.
