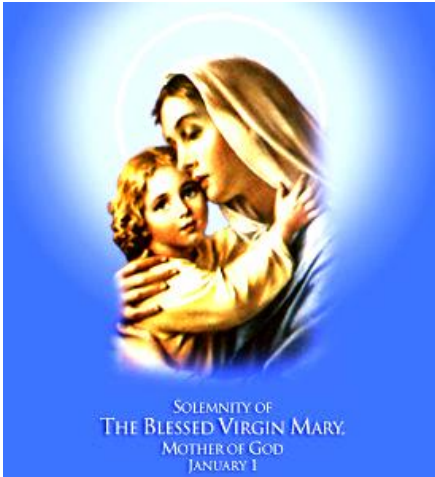
MARCH FOR LIFE
