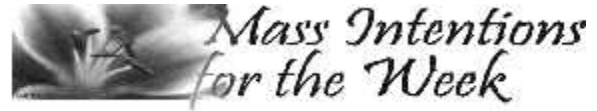

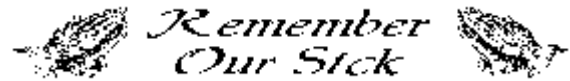

REFLEXIÓN DOMINICAL

La casa estaba inundada de viento, dice el libro de los Hechos de los Apóstoles, después de que Jesús había invocado el Espíritu Santo sobre los apóstoles. Y después de eso, continúa el texto, ellos parecían como borrachos, fuera de sí. Ellos hablaban lenguas que no conocían y eran entendidos por todos. De tímidos llegan a ser valientes, de estar bloqueados en el corazón y en la mente llegan a ser locuaces y desenvueltos. El Espíritu Santo realmente los había embriagado pero de confianza, de esperanza y de alegría.

Lo que sucedió en Jerusalén para los doce, sucede siempre, sucede también para cada uno de nosotros: el Espíritu Santo, aquel viento que envuelve y a veces puede complicar nuestras vidas, pero nunca dejarnos fríos o temerosos, apáticos o repetitivos, siempre nos llena de franqueza, de iniciativa, de innovación creativa, de amor permitiendo que seamos aquello que somos y que demos lo mejor de nosotros mismos.

El Espíritu Santo, *Ruah* en hebreo, la respiración misma de Dios, el comienzo de la vida, aquel por el cual todas las cosas son, se desarrollan y se dirigen en la armonía del cosmos, es quien nos transforma cada día en Cristo y a Él nos devuelve con una vida nueva, realizada y perfecta.

En este día especial, sería bueno abrirle el corazón y veremos cómo Él conduce nuestro pequeño Yo hacia el encuentro con ese Tú, que se manifiesta en cada hermano y hermana, para ofrecerles nuestro amor y perdón: *"Reciban al Espíritu Santo. A los que les perdonen los pecados, les quedarán perdonados"*. El que recibe el Espíritu Santo no puede no perdonar, no puede no romper las barreras y las fronteras que dividen y separan, no puede no acabar con la violencia y abrir el corazón a la compasión fraterna, a la amistad y a la confianza. Recordemos que perdonar es acabar con la presencia del mal y crear vida en armonía y de acuerdo al plan de Dios.

Ahora, hagamos una pausa en nuestros corazones y digamos: *Espíritu de Dios, Ruah, ven de los cuatro vientos y sopla para que tengamos vida y vida en abundancia. Amén.*
