REFLEXIÓN DOMINICAL

El evangelio de este domingo nos muestra a Jesús realizando su primera curación: da la salud a la suegra de Pedro como signo del Reino de vida que ha venido a anunciar. Lo hace en sábado, día de reposo y oración que la interpretación farisea había convertido en una camisa de fuerza, prohibiendo todo tipo de trabajo. Como este evangelio lo hará notar varias veces, más importante es para Jesús dar vida a otro que observar formalidades vacías con pretexto religioso. La respuesta de la nueva discípula al don recibido es el servicio. El comportamiento de esta mujer debe ser imitado por todos los seguidores de Jesús: se acoge verdaderamente el Reino cuando ponemos nuestra vida al servicio de los demás. "La vida del hombre en la tierra es vida de soldado", dice el libro de Job. El signo de vida a través de las curaciones continúa. Jesús rubrica así su enseñanza. No hay que olvidar que en esa época el enfermo es considerado con frecuencia como un pecador. La multitud que se acerca al Señor está sin duda formada por débiles y marginales.

Jesús se aparta para orar en un lugar solitario. En diversas oportunidades los evangelios señalan estos momentos de oración que nos invitan a comulgar con el Señor en la contemplación. Ella está ligada a la preocupación evangelizadora. "Vamos a los pueblos cercanos para predicar", dice Jesús a sus discípulos, la proclamación del Evangelio es una actividad comunitaria y además intensa, el Mesías deja Cafarnaún y recorre toda la Galilea, predicador itinerante que señala el camino hacia el Padre.

De esa intensidad de la evangelización nos habla Pablo. Debo predicar, decía el Señor en el evangelio de Marcos. "¡Ay de mí, si no anuncio el Evangelio", hace eco Pablo. Se trata de dar el mensaje de la única manera posible: gratuitamente, sin esperar recompensa. Lo que se recibe gratis hay que entregarlo con total desinterés. Esa libertad espiritual le permitirá identificarse con aquellos a quienes anuncia el Evangelio, aceptando su condición y haciéndose uno de ellos. "Con los débiles me hice débil" es la regla de oro del evangelizador que nos propone Pablo. Solidario con los que sufren abandono como Job, para hacer nacer en ellos la esperanza del Reino de vida. Amén.
