**PARISHIONER GUIDELINES FOR RETURNING TO MASS:**

You must wear a mask to church; you must wear your mask throughout the entire Mass.

- Please bring your own hand sanitizers to Mass. For your safety and the safety of our priests we ask that you sanitize your hands immediately before going up to Communion.
- Please arrive 15 minutes before Mass begins to allow for seating.
- You may only enter through the Main doors of the church. **NO MASK-NO ENTRANCE!**
- Ushers will seat you – you may only sit in designated areas (designated by a blue X).
- There will be No Sign of Peace.
- Doors will be locked after the start of Mass – No late arrivals.
- Ushers will have baskets for donations on the way out or please feel free to continue to mail them to the Parish Office or use WeShare.

**RECEIVING COMMUNION ONLY THE BODY OF CHRIST WILL BE DISTRIBUTED**

- Please sanitize hands before receiving Communion.
- Communion will only be given out on the hand.
- Do not leave your pew until directed by an usher.
- Even if you are not receiving, you must get up and process with the line so no one has to climb over you to get in or out of the pew. Simply go up to the priest with your hands crossed over your chest for a blessing.
- After receiving the host in your hand, step to the X located 6 feet away from the priest, quickly lift your mask and consume the host – Return to your seat to pray.
- After the final dismissal, Father will proceed to the sacristy. **DO NOT** leave your seat until directed by an usher.
- No gatherings in the parking lot. Please head out as soon as you reach your car.

- Currently we can only have 100 people in the Church (30% capacity).

- We will have one English Mass (4:00pm Saturday) and one Spanish Mass (6:00pm Saturday) also, one English Mass (9:00am Sunday) and one Spanish Mass (10:30am Sunday) until further notice.

**2020-2021 Re-Registration**

We are designing two Religious Education Programs for this year.

**In-House Program**

If we are allowed to resume in the fall, we will run a modified in-school program that will allow us to maintain all Social Distancing protocols and sanitizing schedules.

**Home-School Programs**

If we cannot return to the classrooms, we will have a Home School program that will include occasional Masses, prayer services, adoration, etc. Parents will be committed to be their child's Primary Faith Formation teacher.

So, for Registration for this year, we are asking to register for both options primarily and then as we see what is happening, we will move forward.

Tuition will remain the same as last years "early bird" prices and will not increase at any point this year.

- \$ 155.00 for 1 child
- \$ 210.00 for 2 children
- \$ 265.00 for 3 or more children

If your family is in need of a payment plan, please just let us know when you come into register.

Registration will be TUESDAY, WEDNESDAY or THURSDAY from 9-3pm beginning JULY 28th. Please call ahead 782-5099 or from your car to let us know you are coming in so we can limit the amount of people in at one time. We will announce evening hours in August for drop-off.

We will keep you updated as often and as quickly as we can. Unfortunately, we are at the mercy of the Archdiocese of New York, Governor Cuomo and the Monroe-Woodbury School district. So, we are going day by day as I am sure you all are also.

**SU PALABRA HOY** *por el Reverendo William J. Reilly*

**Décimo Séptimo Domingo en Tiempo Ordinario  
26 de julio de 2020**

"El Reino de los Cielos es semejante a un tesoro escondido en un campo que, al encontrarlo un hombre, vuelve a esconderlo y, por la alegría que le da, va, vende todo lo que tiene y compra el campo aquel. También es semejante el Reino de los Cielos a un mercader que anda buscando perlas finas, y que, al encontrar una perla de gran valor, va, vende todo lo que tiene y la compra."

Durante esta época del año no es extraño encontrar ya entrada la tarde a una persona en la playa, yendo de aquí para allá con un detector de metals, escuchando el sonido que revelará una moneda u otra cosa valiosa entre la arena. A menudo me pregunto si algo de valor aparece.
