Bishop J. Mark Spalding and the Diocese of Nashville recently shared the positive results of the Diocesan Campaign Planning Study completed earlier this year. Prior to the temporary cessation of public Masses announced on March 17, the diocese successfully completed a study conducted by the Steier Group, a Catholic development consulting firm. Based on the information gathered, representatives of the firm reported their findings and recommendations to Bishop Spalding and the diocesan finance council, presbyterial council and development committee.
