**THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST**

**First Reading: Genesis 14:18-20**

Melchizedek was the king of Salem, but he acts as a priest also. First, he sets a feast of bread and wine for Abram after his victory over the armies of five kings. Then he offers Abram a blessing.

**Second Reading: I Corinthians 11:23-26**

Addressing the Corinthian community, Paul is aware that they have not been living as a loving group but have split into factions. This makes their Eucharist celebrations faulty. He recounts for them Jesus' offering to the Father through the consecrated bread and wine of His Body and Blood.

**Gospel: Luke 9:11b-17**

The miraculous feeding of the five thousand foreshadows the Eucharist. Luke has Our Lord using the same words over the bread and fish as He will use over the bread and wine at the Last Supper.
