THIRTEENTH SUNDAY

First Reading: I Kings 19:16b, 19-21

Elijah's desire to resign his mission leads to Yahweh naming Elisha his successor. Elisha must abandon his family and his old way of life to follow in Elijah's path.

Second Reading: Galatians 5:1, 13-18

Paul asks that the community preserve their freedom in Christ. They are to conduct themselves by living in the Spirit. This will certainly involve struggle with the demands of "the flesh."

Gospel: Luke 9:51-62

Jesus has begun His journey to Jerusalem, and He teaches along the way in Luke's story design. Here Jesus chooses not to rebuke the Samaritans for their behavior. Then He moves on to remind His followers of the cost of discipleship by using three proverbs involving hyperbole.
