SIXTEENTH SUNDAY

First Reading: Genesis 18:1-10a

The Lord, as mediated by three men visitors, appears to Abraham. This is a storytelling device that points out both the nearness and the mysteriousness of God.

Second Reading: Colossians 1:24-28

St. Paul "fills up" through his afflictions what is "lacking" in those of Christ and it gives him what he needs to endure for preaching the gospel authentically. He speaks of the mystery of the word of God that is open to all.

Gospel: Luke 10:38-42

Martha and her sister Mary host Jesus in their home, typifying the practice of the early Church. "The better part", the one thing most important for Jesus, was listening to His word. This Mary did while Martha bustled about.
