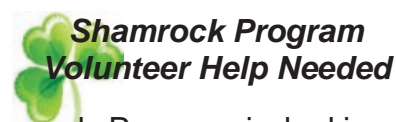

Below is a synopsis of each program currently in full swing:

**OUR FATHER'S KITCHEN-** Providing a hot, nutritious meal to approximately 100 people every Wednesday evening from 5pm-6:30 pm (Work begins at noon)

**OFK FOOD PANTRY-** Provides food for the week to over 250 people per week. This includes meat, dairy, fresh produce, canned goods, pasta, and bread every Wednesday from 10am-11:30pm

**OFK MOBILE FOOD PANTRY-** delivers meat, dairy, fresh produce, canned goods, pasta, and bread every Monday and Friday to those who are homebound, sick or elderly on limited incomes. The bus delivers to over 75 people each week.

**THE SONSHINE BOUTIQUE-**Provides clothing and household items for extremely reasonable prices every Thursday from 12 till 2pm. The funds are used to support the ministries of Parish Outreach and individuals in need.

**OUR MOTHER'S CUPBOARD-** Provides diapers, wipes, formula and baby food for those in need every Thursday from 12 till 2pm

**THE ST MOTHER TERESA FURNITURE PROGRAM -** picks up furniture from generous donors and delivers furniture to those in need.
