**SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT**

**Reading I: Isaiah 11: 1-10**

This section describes the coming rule of Emmanuel, or "God with us." He will be of King David's line; be blest with many spiritual gifts; and His reign will bring true peace and justice.

**Reading II: Romans 15: 4-9**

Viewed from the perspective of our spiritual history, sufferings actually give us a basis for hope. Paul makes a plea for unity among the people. Jesus had to be a Jew in order to serve them, but that does not mean that Gentiles, such as Romans, are excluded from benefiting from God's promises.

**The Gospel: Matthew 3: 1-12**

John the Baptist, acting as Our Lord's precursor, preaches essentially the same message as Jesus, namely "Repent for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." John condemns the Pharisees and Sadducees as a "brood of vipers." The coming Messiah will offer a superior baptism to John's, one of the Holy Spirit and fire."

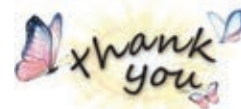
