SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Reading I: Isaiah 49: 3, 5-6

The prophet presents himself as another Jeremiah, with references to having a call while still in the womb, and his obligation to fulfill it. He knows that he is to be “a light to the nations” with his announcements.

Reading II: I Corinthians 1: 1-3

Paul uses a standard letter introduction, and then claims to have the same apostolic authority as the original Twelve. He tells his readers that they have been set apart by God and must work to be worthy of that.

The Gospel: John 1: 29-34

The writer tells his readers that the descent of the Spirit upon Jesus was the sign for John the Baptist that He was the one designated by God. He is “the Lamb of God” with all the rich meaning of that term making Him the ultimate sacrifice for our sins.


