## SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

## Reading I: Leviticus 19: 1-2, 17-18

Moses gets instructions from the Lord that demand of the Israelites to be a holy people. This gets specific with a ban on hatred of other people, along with grudges. There is also an obligation to practice fraternal correction.

## Reading II: I Corinthians 3: 16-23

Paul addresses the extant divisions among his readers by comparing them to a temple, which is a unity among many components. He tells them that holiness comes from service to others. Real wisdom derives from belonging to Christ.

## The Gospel: Matthew 5: 38-48

Continuing his account of Christ's teachings condensed to "the Sermon on the Mount", Matthew shows us Jesus preaching against retaliation toward enemies. The heroic stance taken by a martyr actually gives the persecutor a bad image. "Being perfect" involves obedience to the whole Law, conforming to the divine ideal.

## **Building and Grounds Committee Update: February 2020**

Since our last update in September, the Parish Building and Grounds Committee has been using funds from the “Renew and Rebuild Campaign” to complete a number of exterior projects before the onset of winter weather. Most of the work has been focused on resolving leaks and drainage problems at the Parish Center.

1. We replaced the leaking drainpipe that runs under the walkway by the flagpole in order to prevent further sink holes and we installed new catch basins.
2. We installed a new walkway from the parking lot to the Parish Center that meets requirements for handicap accessibility.
3. Small leaks in the gabled roofs on the Parish Center and in the end walls of the gym have been sealed.
4. Snow guards on the gym roof have been repaired.
5. New gutters and downspouts have been installed on the Parish Center Building.
6. New exterior lighting has been installed on the back of the church to better illuminate the main entrance to the lower church and the adjacent parking area.
7. The wiring in the lower church hall has been upgraded.
8. A new air conditioning compressor has been installed in the church.

We had hoped to repair the front entrance to the church and the surrounding façade this past autumn, but the early onset of cold winter compelled us to postpone this work until early spring.
