THE SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION: Confessions are heard on Saturday morning from 9:00 to 10:00 am and anytime with Fr. Joe upon reasonable request.

THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM: Second & fourth Sundays at 12:30 pm. Expectant parents may contact the parish office to arrange for the baptism preparation session held on the third Thursday of every month. The class is held in the Parish Center—Education Building, Room 7 at 7:30 pm. Adults are baptized and confirmed at the Easter Vigil after completing the process of the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults, (RCIA).

RCIA - Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: A process for those who wish to learn more about the Catholic Faith, or for Catholic adults, who after being baptized as infants, wish now to receive the sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation. For more information, please call our Parish Office.

THE SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY: It is an honor for our parish to celebrate marriage with couples. Please contact the parish immediately after engagement to begin the preparation process. The recommended time for preparation is six months.

Deacon Paul is honored to be selected as the Grand Marshall for the 2021 Woodbury Memorial Day Parade. Paul was born in February 1950 to Paul and Rose Weireter in Brooklyn, NY. He was the second of four children with two sisters and a brother. Paul went to high school in Brooklyn and graduated from Baruch College in New York. He also holds MBA from New York Institute of technology.

While in college, Paul joined the Navy Reserves. He went to bootcamp at the Great Lakes Navel Training Center by Lake Michigan. In the reserves, Paul served on two World War II Era destroyers, out of the Brooklyn Navy Yard, USS Dyess, DD-880 and USS Moale DD-693.

After graduation from college, he spent two years on active duty at the Naval examination Center in Great Lakes, Illinois, working in computer analysis and statistical evaluation of the navy wide exams. Paul would joke that he joined the Navy to see the world and they sent him to the farthest port from salt water in these United States.

After his active-duty service, Paul remained in the reserves for several years and during part of that time served on a submarine tender out of Charleston, SC. USS Orion AS-18.

In civilian life, he is a CPA working in tax and consulting. His specialty is in the areas of estates and trusts.

Paul moved with his wife, Karen, to Highland Mills, in 1981. They are members of St. Patrick's Church. Paul was ordained a deacon by Cardinal O'Connor in 1988 and has served our Parish and community ever since. He has officiated at many baptisms, weddings, and funerals. He was also a Religious Education instructor for over thirty years.

Paul and Karen had six daughters and they all attended Monroe Woodbury Schools. He has eight grandchildren, whom he loves very much, and takes advantage of opportunities to fish and play golf with them. Paul is a member of the Woodbury American Legion Post 779, The Woodbury Community Association, and the Knights of Columbus. He encourages all Woodbury residents to remember the veterans who served this country so selflessly, and their families who supported them.
