A reminder that next weekend we will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation in our parish at the vigil Mass on Saturday, February 15th. We are overjoyed that Bishop Cahill will be conferring the gifts of the Holy Spirit on our young adults. Please keep them in prayer this week. Ask the Spirit of God to deeply touch them and enlighten their hearts with the fire of God's love.

It is also a good opportunity to reflect on your own Confirmation. Do you remember which bishop was present? Who was your sponsor? What it felt like when hands were placed upon your head? What the oil smelled like? And if you are older, before the current Rite of Confirmation was promulgated, do you remember being struck on the cheek? And perhaps most importantly, do you see the work of the Holy Spirit in your life?

Sacraments—those outward signs chosen by God to give grace—are vital to our faith. Without them we would flounder to know God. With the season of Lent fast approaching, it is a wonderful time of the year to re-evaluate our faith and prayer life.

May we always pray:

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful. And kindle in them the fire of your love.
 Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And you will renew the face of the earth.
 Lord, by the light of the Holy Spirit you have taught the hearts of your faithful.
 In the same Spirit help us to relish what is right and always rejoice in your consolation.
 We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.
