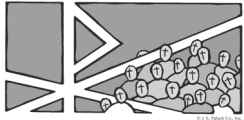

BISHOP'S STATEMENT ON RECENT VIOLENCE

Bishop Joe S. Vásquez, of the Diocese of Austin, issued the following statement on Friday, July 8:

Last night, during a peaceful protest related to the recent shootings and deaths of Alton Sterling in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, and Philando Castile in Falcon Heights, Minnesota, 11 law enforcement officers were shot, five of whom were killed. Our hearts ache for the families of the young men who were killed in Louisiana and Minnesota, and our hearts also ache for the police officers who were wounded and the families of the police officers who were killed in Dallas. As Christians, we hold fast to our faith in Jesus Christ who broke down the dividing wall of hostility and division between us (Eph 2:14). Because we believe every life is sacred and every person is precious, we must continue to pray for the conversion of all people to safeguard the inherent dignity and value of every human life.

We recognize the frustration and anger people feel—particularly those who are marginalized because of race or ethnicity—as well as the distress and anger stemming from assaults against law enforcement officers. We must work to unite and heal our communities. Let us join together and pray for the families of those who have suffered or have been affected by violence, hatred and oppression.
