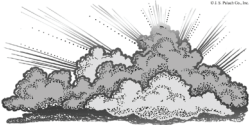

The family and friends of our Charro Day Queen Candidates are hard at work. Here's what they have coming up:

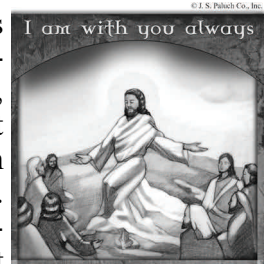
