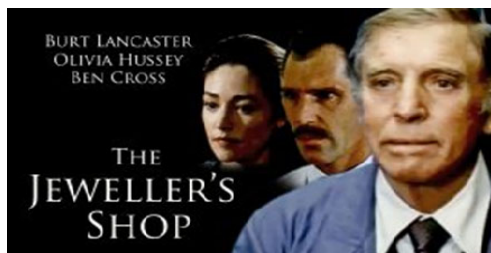

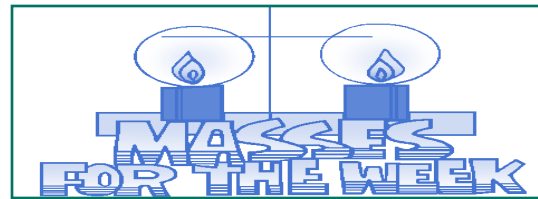
As usual, our monthly food collection will be the second week of the month. Since everyone is so generous with their contributions, perhaps you would be interested to learn how the pantry works at Catholic Charities Community Services of Rockland in Haverstraw...

Food recipients are required to register with the office, showing ID and proof of income and residency. If qualified, their names are placed on a list so that when they come to the pantry, they can sign next to their name and the date they were there. The pantry distributes food three times a week, at different times.

Each registered recipient may come once monthly to receive food although the people are also able to go to any other pantry in the county, depending on the qualifications there. Everyone is given similar bags of nutritious, unexpired groceries so that one family doesn't feel cheated that another family received something better. The following food is currently on hand: Cereal - cold or hot; Pasta; Canned vegetables; Canned Fruit; and frozen meat or chicken. Sometimes bagels or bread is donated for distribution, and In the summer, fresh produce grown in the pantry garden is picked for everyone. This month, the pantry is in need of the following, nonperishable items:

Rice all varieties, peanut butter, jelly, tuna, pasta sauce, macaroni & cheese, dried or canned beans.

Again, your generosity is tremendously appreciated.

St. Paul Miki was the son of a Japanese military leader. He was educated at a Jesuit college and joined the Jesuits in 1580, and became known for his eloquent preaching. He was crucified on February 5th with 25 other Catholics during the persecution of Christians under the Taiko, Toyotomi Hideyoshi, ruler of Japan.

St. Scholastica was born in Italy, according to a 9th century tradition, she was the twin sister of Benedict of Nursia. Scholastica is the patron saint of nuns, and convulsive children and is invoked against storms and rain.

Her memorial is February 10th. She sacrificed many opportunities for her and her brother, just so they could get closer to God.
