SACRAMENTAL LITURGIES: BAPTISM

When Catechumens were brought into the Church for their baptism at the Easter Vigil, they processed around the church, while the community prayed for them. They then knelt before the congregation as the faithful invoked the names of the martyrs and saints to pray for their conversion. During the celebration of infant baptism, the community that gathers continues to pray for those who will be baptized, for their parents and godparents and for all the church. Likewise, we still invoke the saints, including where possible the patrons of those to be baptized. It is a reminder that the entire church participates in the sacramental action, even those who have died and have preceded us in faith.
