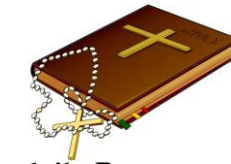

Fourth Sunday of Advent Year A
Isaiah 7: 10-16 Ahaz, the king, refuses to seek a sign from God. God gives a sign, a maiden gives birth to a son, named Immanuel - God with us.
Romans 1:1-7 Paul feels compelled to proclaim the gospel he has received, the good news about Jesus, a descendant of David and the Son of God.
Matthew 1:18-25 Matthew relates how Joseph understood the birth of Jesus was the fulfillment of Isaiah’s prophecy about Immanuel.
Discussion Question: What are the signs that tell us whether we are doing the will of God or not?
