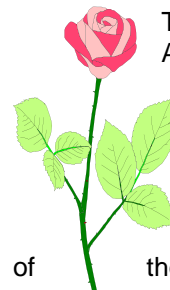
PRAY FOR

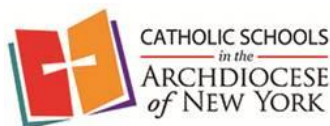
