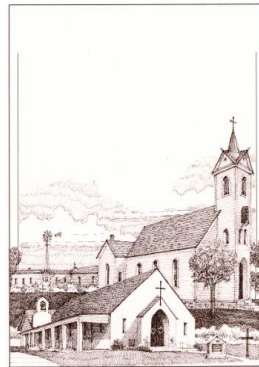

Sealed in blood and ratified in ritual, a covenant is a tremendously serious promise. In Exodus, the covenant between the LORD and the Chosen People was sealed with the blood of sacrificial animals. In Hebrews, Christ is portrayed as the high priest, offering his own Blood as a new covenant for our redemption. In Mark, the Last Supper is the first Eucharist. Jesus shares his own Body and Blood, the blood of the new covenant. He continues to do so today.

Una alianza, sellada con la sangre y ratificada por el rito, es una promesa enormemente seria. En el libro del Éxodo la alianza entre el Señor y el pueblo escogido fue sellada con la sangre de animales sacrificados. En la carta a los hebreos se describe a Cristo como el sumo sacerdote, que ofrece su propia sangre como una alianza nueva por nuestra redención. En el Evangelio de Marcos la Última Cena es la primera Eucaristía. Jesús comparte su propio cuerpo y su propia sangre, la sangre de la nueva alianza. Él continúa haciendo lo mismo hoy.
