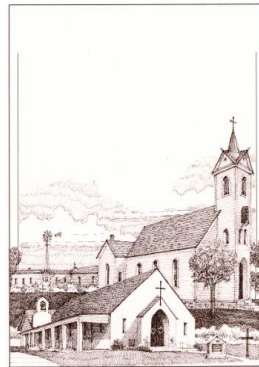

Most of the Gospel readings during Ordinary Time this year are taken from the Gospel of Saint Mark. Mark wrote his Gospel as a dramatic story with Jesus at the center. Jesus is always moving, inviting his disciples—and us—to follow. Mark wanted those who heard or read his Gospel to come to understand Jesus and recognize him as the Son of God. As is typical, Jesus moves quickly through a growing crowd in today's Gospel, rebuking those who misunderstand his power, warning those who blaspheme against the Holy Spirit, and redefining their understanding of family.

Como de costumbre Jesús se mueve rápido entre la creciente muchedumbre en el Evangelio de hoy y reprende a aquellos que malentienden su poder, y además amonesta a los que blasfeman contra el Espíritu Santo y redefine el significado de familia.
