June: 15-19 Vacation Bible School (*tentative*)

In-person classes have been split into two groups (A and B) and will alternate between classes at Good Shepherd and at home as follows:

NOTE: Classes meeting at Good Shepherd will follow the most current CDC guidelines children which suggests:

- **sitting 6 feet apart** in class,
- facing the same direction as much as possible,
- and **wearing face masks** (from the time they exit the car to the time they re-enter the car).

We have designated up and down staircases; please follow the directions of safety monitors, office staff, and catechists. We will also have visible signs to direct everyone.
