From the Pastor...Proper Etiquette: What does a person do when either a priest or deacon goes to the Tabernacle after Mass, opens the door, and takes out the Blessed Sacrament to administer the Holy Eucharist to someone?

If you find yourself at Church and this happens, our response is always to show due reverence and respect for our Eucharistic Lord. It is proper to pause any action or talking that is taking place and to remain silent. If one is able, a person should either bow or genuflect. Once the Blessed Sacrament has been placed back into the Tabernacle, a person may resume their conversation or action.

NH Catholic Charities Appeal: This weekend we begin the annual NH Catholic Charities Appeal here in our parish. This appeal will run throughout the month of May. As we all know, the pandemic has had a negative impact for many people. This is especially true for low-income families and other vulnerable groups within our state and country. Your support of Catholic Charities provides healing and hope for so many in these difficult times.

Since the pandemic began, 134,590 pounds of food have been distributed to homebound seniors across Greater Manchester and Greater Nashua. The CareGivers program has helped to ensure people have had adequate access to food and nourishment during these trying times. 4,349 NH residents have reached out for assistance around food, transportation, housing and other essential needs to Catholic Charities offices around our state.

When it comes to Mental Health Counseling Services, NH Catholic Charities has been able to use teletherapy to assist more than 300 individuals dealing with increased stress, anxiety and difficulties adjusting to the pandemic or everyday life circumstances.

On behalf of NH Catholic Charities, I offer you my thanks for whatever assistance you are able to give.

COVID19 Requirements: Although Gov. Sununu has lifted the state mandate for wearing masks, the Bishop has not lifted that requirement for our parishes. He is asking all parishes to continue to follow the CDC and Federal government guidelines of wearing masks, sanitizing our churches, washing hands, and maintaining the 6' distance when in church.
