

My Dear Friends in Christ,

**“They have taken the Lord from the tomb,
and we don't know where they put him.”**

Not exactly what we picture on Easter: these words from Mary of Magdala clash with the alleged joy of this day of days. *A missing Jesus?* This scene at the tomb does not mesh with Easter lilies, Alleluias, and joyous hymns. In one instant there was death, but now in this moment, Mary questions whether someone has gone so far as to steal the Lord from his burial place.

Yet such a question from Mary is most appropriate for the world in which we live, a world in which, so often, we are compelled to ask ourselves, “Where is God?”

If a contradiction is present in calling the day on which Jesus died “good,” then also ought we question how we can sing Alleluia when the Lord is, at least at first glance, missing. But this, my brothers and sisters, is in fact the very kernel of truth at the center of the Easter Mystery. “They” have not taken the Lord: He is not dead, but rather, raised. The Lord’s triumph over death is not the particular answer that is natural to humans (we would rather He not have died in the first place), yet as is so often the case, our God is active in deceptive ways, crafting a greater and more lasting salvation than we could have ever imagined.

This Easter Season begs thanks to all our musicians, liturgical ministers, altar servers, Frs. Bob and John, Br. Roger, Andy Bauer, Deanne May, and most of all to you, both visitors and parishioners: Christ is indeed risen and lives within all of us. Alleluia!
