## *From the Pastor's Desk*

### *Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time: Welcome the Spirit!*

As we enjoy the heat and humidity of the month of July, we welcome the breath of fresh air: the Spirit who “comes to the aid of our weakness.” Paul is direct with the Christian community in Rome: “we do not know how to pray as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes...for the holy ones according to God’s will.” Because of our baptism into Jesus Christ we have a new relationship with God and the Church. We are members of Christ’s Body and, as we hear in the Baptismal ritual, we truly are sons and daughters of God the Father. The Holy Spirit is given to us in Baptism to help foster our spiritual growth as sons and daughters. The Holy Spirit reminds us of all that Jesus taught us and assists us to live our daily life in Christ. Have you welcomed the Spirit fully into your life?

In today’s gospel passage, Jesus uses several parables and images to describe the Kingdom of heaven. He never tires of trying to use real life images to teach his disciples, and us, about realities greater than ourselves, such as the Kingdom of heaven. He uses the image of a field in which many weeds grow among the wheat, the image of a small mustard seed which grows into a large bush, the image of yeast which leavens dough on its way to becoming bread. Each of these parables teaches us something about the Kingdom of heaven: it is reserved for the good harvest, not the weeds; it is sown and takes root in us often in small and unassuming ways, but grows, like the mustard seed, mysteriously and quietly into something great; a little bit of “kingdom life” goes a long way in us!

What images do you think Jesus might use today to describe the Kingdom of heaven? What means of communication would grab our attention? How can the Holy Spirit assist us in a greater understanding and appreciation of the Kingdom of heaven in our daily lives? Let us pray with and for one another as we ponder the mysteries of God’s Word and attempt to put into practice all that Jesus teaches us. Let us learn from the Spirit how to pray with confidence, devotion, gratitude, and trust.

I continue to be grateful for everyone’s cooperation in sanitizing their hands when you enter the church and for wearing masks or other face coverings during the entire time that you are in church, whether at Mass or for private prayer. **May I please remind you that masks should not be worn under the chin?**

At this time it is very difficult for us to plan for events in the fall. Many weddings have been rescheduled until 2021 and many baptisms are being scheduled presently. For health and safety concerns, we are trying to schedule individual baptisms, which makes scheduling a little difficult, but important to keep in mind when calling the office to schedule a baptism.
