From the Pastor's Desk

29th Sunday in Ordinary Time: "What do You Wish me to do for You?"

In our Gospel passage today James and John go to Jesus with a special request: "Teacher, we want you to do for us whatever we ask of you." Jesus asks what it is. Their reply must have surprised the other ten apostles who became indignant at James and John for making the request: "Grant that in your glory we may sit one at your right and the other at your left." In other words, "assure us of places of honor when you come into your Kingdom!"

Jesus' response and the teaching that follows is right in line with his teaching over the last several weeks about the requirements of discipleship. Jesus asks if the two brothers could "drink the cup" that he would drink or if they could accept the baptism with which he is baptized (these would involve his suffering and his death.) They agree that they can and Jesus assures them that, as disciples, they will endure their share of the Passion. However, Jesus tells them that it is not his decision who sits at his right or his left. That is reserved to the Father.

Jesus goes on to remind the Twelve that to be great involves becoming a servant. The way to first place is through service to others. He reminds them that he himself did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many. We know that those were not just words spoken to inspire the Apostles; they were words he put into action in his own life. We can, too. But first a few thoughts for our reflection:

What do we ask Jesus to do for us? Do it sound like a reasonable request?

What is the manner of our asking, what is our attitude? Do we demand things from the Lord?

Do we feel somehow "entitled" to what we ask for?

Do we ask in faith, believing that we have already received what we ask or do we have doubts?

How do we react to the Lord's response to our prayers and requests, especially, if the answer is not the one we wanted or expected?

Has being a disciple of Jesus brought me suffering in any way? If so, in what ways? How have I accepted it?

Do I unite my sufferings to the those of Jesus?

Do I have my eye on "greatness" in the eyes of God? Am I willing to be "the slave of all?"

Could I envision myself offering my very life as a ransom for others?
