From the Pastor's Desk - The Solemnity of Corpus Christi

Each year at this time, I try to recall the wisdom and inspiration of our late Holy Father, Saint John Paul II, who spoke such encouraging and often challenging words to us. As we gather to celebrate this wonderful solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, please allow me to recall once again words spoken to the youth of the world whom he loved so much:

“Do not be afraid to go out into the streets and into public places, like the first apostles who preached Christ and the good news of salvation in the squares of cities, towns, and villages. This is not the time to be ashamed of the Gospel. It is the time to preach it from the rooftops! Do not be afraid to break out of comfortable and routine modes of living in order to take up the challenge of making Christ known in the modern world. It is YOU who must ‘go out into the roads and lanes’ and invite everyone you meet to the banquet that God has prepared for His People.”

I often reflect on this passage and share it in a variety of settings because it is not just a message for our young people! Taking to heart these words of Saint John Paul II, we would normally process around the block today, literally bringing our Lord into the streets in order that His Presence may be a source of grace, blessing, peace, and joy for all who will look upon Him. We will have to wait until next year for our Eucharistic Procession, but I am already thinking bigger than just a walk around the parish property. Perhaps a procession route that includes down to Lake Avenue and back up to Park Avenue before returning to the church?

May our celebration of the Lord's Presence in the Eucharist inspire and invite others to join us at the Table of the Lord, may our witness cause others to stop and think, at least for a moment, about the promises and the blessings that God has shared with us. Let us carry the Lord with us, in our hearts, in a special way throughout the day. Let us not get distracted by those things which could easily take our mind and devotion off of the Lord. Rather, let us keep our eyes fixed on the Lord, recall how many people came out to “see the spectacle that was passing by” as he made his way to Calvary, how many people jeered and made fun of him, and how few stood by his side at the final moments of his life. Remember the fidelity of his Mother, Mary, together with Mary Magdalene and the Beloved Disciple who remained with Jesus. Jesus is present here among us in the Eucharist; let us remain with him. Let us take him with us to those with whom we live, work, and share life with.

While we celebrate this wonderful day in honor of Jesus Christ present in the Eucharist, we are also reminded that it is our feast day, too...for the Lord can be no closer to us than when we receive Him in the Eucharist. We become one with Him and He lives in and through us. By extension, we are the Body of Christ and so we celebrate who we are and who we become in the sacrament of Holy Communion! May God be praised for His goodness to us! May others come to know the Lord through us. *“This is no time to be afraid to go out into the streets and public places, like the first apostles who preached Christ and the Good News of salvation in the squares of cities, towns, and villages.”*
