From Fr. Mike

There seems to be some apprehension to our new format to the faith formation program and expectations to our new guidelines for confirmation prep classes. It appears that the two most common comments are, that 1) they do not want to be told which mass to attend and 2) all the church wants is money. When I sat down with Fr. Adam over a year and a half ago, he expressed to me that one of his concerns for the parish was Mass attendance while the children are in faith formation classes. In order to address this we have incorporated the 9:30 am Mass as a part of the curriculum. Will there be some extenuating circumstances? Of course! But those can be worked out with dialogue. But we have to focus on being a parish family which has the Eucharist as the point unity. As for the second point, let me be very clear: This is NOT about money or how much you give to the church, but more importantly once again, about being part of our parish family. I have told many families that donating as little as a dollar in our parish envelope is acceptable. Again, underlining the fact that this is not about money but more importantly, about coming to church as a family of faith.

In my last parish of residence in Wayne, there was another church less than twenty minutes away (which was part of another diocese) that did not require the two years of preparation for Confirmation that the Diocese of Paterson required and had lesser requirements for service. A group of about 15-20 parents were making their move to bring their children to this new parish in order to circumvent our diocesan requirement. One very bold and courageous family came and spoke with me in person. They shared with me their concerns and fears. Not wanting to leave their parish which they had belonged to since their own time of coming to "CCD," we came to an agreement about our requirements and their intentions which I brought to the attention of the pastor.

This family stayed, they continued to come to church with their children almost each and every week. They are a shining example of what it means to be committed, courageous and Catholic. Was it always easy? No. Was it always convenient? No. Did their daughters make their Confirmation with their friends? No. But, in the end, they came to visit me in Netcong and thanked me for listening to their needs and for challenging them in their faith. It was because of their return to church as a family that they were able to deal with some very serious issues that came their way because of their relationship with the Lord and by the support of our parish family.

This is my hope! This is my prayer as your parish priest! That you take our new requirements as a challenge of your faith to draw closer to the Lord and to feel His loving care and support. It is always going to be easy? No. Will it always be convenient? No. But I hope and pray that if you are faithful to the Lord and His command of "eating His flesh and drinking His blood" that He will give you the strength and courage you need to draw closer to Him and His Church. I understand that this is a huge change from what has "always been done in the past" but just because it was done a certain way in the past does not make it correct or even better.

I was sent to Saint Michael Church by the bishop to draw you closer to the Lord Jesus. It has been my experience in my last assignments, that calling people to draw closer to the Eucharistic Lord is not only making them better Catholics, but as importantly, assisting them in having a closer relationship with the Lord Himself. As I mentioned in a previous bulletin, to many this can be a "hard saying" and as some decided to "walk with Him (Jesus) no longer" (John 6:66). And the Lord Himself allowed them to leave! Come and stay with the Lord. Come and enjoy His love and His peace. Come be nourished at the Table of the Lord and see how kind and merciful His unconditional love truly is! I invite you to join us in making the sacrifice, the commitment of being closer to the Lord each and every week. And to those who already make this sacrifice, you know the rewards of being faithful to God, for He will always be faithful to you! God bless you all and I hope to see you in church soon!

*EL MILAGRO EUCARÍSTICO CON EL QUE
SE INSTITUYÓ LA SOLEMNIDAD DEL
CORPUS CHRISTI*



La Catedral de Orvieto en Italia custodia uno de los milagros Eucarísticos más importantes en la historia de la Iglesia y que motivó al Papa Urbano IV a instituir la Solemnidad del Corpus Christi.

A mediados del siglo XIII el P. Pedro de Praga dudaba sobre la presencia de Cristo en la Eucaristía y realizó una peregrinación a Roma para rogar sobre la tumba de San Pedro una gracia de fe. A su regreso, mientras celebraba la Santa Misa en Bolsena, en la cripta de Santa Cristina, la Sagrada Hostia sangró manchando el corporal con la preciosísima sangre.

La noticia llegó rápidamente al Papa Urbano IV, que se encontraba muy cerca en Orvieto, y mandó que se le lleve el corporal. La venerada reliquia fue llevada en procesión y se dice que el Pontífice, al ver el milagro, se arrodilló frente al corporal y luego se lo mostró a la población.

Más adelante, el Santo Padre publicó la bula "Transiturus", con la que ordenó que se celebrara la Solemnidad del Corpus Christi en toda la Iglesia el jueves después del domingo de la Santísima Trinidad.

Asimismo, el Papa Urbano IV encomendó a Santo Tomás

de Aquino la preparación de un oficio litúrgico para la fiesta y la composición de himnos, que se entonan hasta el día de hoy: Tantum Ergo, Lauda Sion.

La santa reliquia se conserva en la Catedral de Orvieto y se puede apreciar en una capilla edificada en honor a este milagro Eucarístico. El corporal sale en procesión cada año durante la Fiesta del Corpus Christi y preside las celebraciones Eucarísticas en la Catedral.

San Juan Pablo II, durante su visita a la Catedral de Orvieto en 1990, señaló que "Jesús se ha convertido en nuestro alimento espiritual para proclamar la soberana dignidad del hombre, para reivindicar sus derechos y sus justas exigencias, para transmitirle el secreto de la victoria definitiva sobre el mal y la comunión eterna con Dios".
