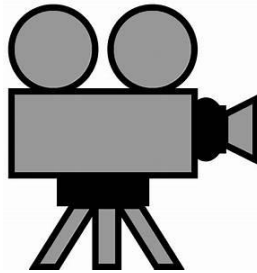

RITE OF CHRISTIAN
INITIATION FOR ADULTS
INTERESTED IN BECOMING CATHOLIC OR
COMPLETING YOUR CONFIRMATION AS AN ADULT?

This program helps adults and young adults learn about the Catholic Faith and prepare them for the initiation sacraments that are typically celebrated at the Easter Vigil Mass which will be on April 20 this coming spring (2019). Candidates and their sponsors meet together on Thursday evenings from the fall through Easter, plus two sessions after Easter.

Candidates include:

- Those who are not yet baptized preparing to celebrate Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist
- Those baptized in another Christian denomination preparing to become Catholic
- Plus those who were baptized Catholic, but not yet confirmed, preparing to celebrate their Confirmation, and perhaps First Eucharist.

APRENDE SOBRE TU FE!

El Domingo pasada veíamos como La Misa consta, en cierto modo, de dos partes, a saber, la **Liturgia de la Palabra** y la **Liturgia Eucarística**, las cuales están tan estrechamente unidas entre sí. Además de estas dos partes esenciales, la Misa consta de algunos ritos que inician la celebración y otros que la concluyen. De este modo podremos decir que la Misa está estructuralmente organizada de la siguiente manera:

- A) Ritos iniciales
- B) Liturgia de la palabra.
- C) Liturgia Eucarística.
- D) Rito de Conclusión.

A) Ritos iniciales

Los ritos que preceden a la Liturgia de la Palabra, es decir, **la entrada**, el **saludo**, el **acto penitencial**, el **Señor, ten piedad**, el **Gloria**, y la **oración colecta**, tienen el carácter de exordio, de introducción y de preparación.

La finalidad de ellos es hacer que los fieles reunidos en la unidad construyan la comunión y se dispongan debidamente a escuchar la Palabra de Dios y a celebrar dignamente la Eucaristía. En algunas celebraciones, que se unen con la Misa, según la norma de los libros litúrgicos, se omiten los ritos iniciales o se realizan de modo especial.
