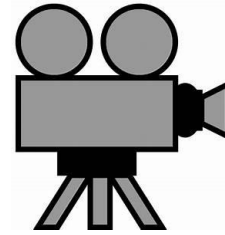

## **RCIA RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS**

***INTERESTED IN BECOMING CATHOLIC OR  
COMPLETING YOUR CONFIRMATION AS AN  
ADULT?***

This program helps adults and young adults learn about the Catholic Faith and prepare them for the initiation sacraments that are typically celebrated at the Easter Vigil Mass which will be on April 20 this coming spring (2019). Candidates and their sponsors meet together on Thursday evenings from the fall through Easter, plus two sessions after Easter.

**APRENDE SOBRE TU FE!**

Como ya sabemos, la Santa Misa comienza con los Ritos Iniciales los cuales ayudan a que los fieles se dispongan debidamente a escuchar la Palabra de Dios y a celebrar dignamente la Eucaristía. En los ritos iniciales lo primero que tenemos es la **Procesión de Entrada.**

Estando el pueblo reunido, el sacerdote avanza dirigiéndose hacia el altar con el diácono, acólitos y los ministros, dando así inicio a la ceremonia con el canto de entrada. La finalidad de este canto es abrir la celebración, promover la unión de quienes se están congregados e introducir su espíritu en el misterio del tiempo litúrgico o de la festividad, así como acompañar la procesión del sacerdote y los ministros.

Si no hay canto de entrada, los fieles o algunos de ellos o un lector, leerán la antifona propuesta en el Misal, o si no el mismo sacerdote, quien también puede adaptarla a manera de monición inicial.

*Amonesta el Apóstol a los fieles que se reúnen esperando unidos la venida de su Señor, que canten todos juntos salmos, himnos y cánticos inspirados (cfr. Col 3,16). Pues el canto es signo de la exultación del corazón (cfr. Hch 2, 46). De ahí que San Agustín dice con razón: "Cantar es propio del que ama".*
