RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS

*INTERESTED IN BECOMING CATHOLIC OR
COMPLETING YOUR CONFIRMATION AS AN
ADULT?*

This program helps adults and young adults learn about the Catholic Faith and prepare them for the initiation sacraments that are typically celebrated at the Easter Vigil Mass which will be on April 20 this coming spring (2019). Candidates and their sponsors meet together on Thursday evenings from the fall through Easter, plus two sessions after Easter.

Candidates include:

- Those who are not yet baptized preparing to celebrate Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist
- Those baptized in another Christian denomination preparing to become Catholic
- Plus those who were baptized Catholic, but not yet confirmed, preparing to celebrate their Confirmation, and perhaps First Eucharist.

APRENDE SOBRE TU FE!



Al inicio de este aprendizaje enfocado en la explicación de lo que sucede en la Santa Misa, les explicaba que la Misa consiste de dos partes muy importantes: La Liturgia de la Palabra y la Liturgia de Eucaristía.

En esta primera parte, la Liturgia de la Palabra, decíamos que iniciaba con un

Rito Introdutorio el cual hemos venido desarrollando uno a uno para lograr un conocimiento detallado sobre todos ellos. La procesión de entrada, el saludo, El acto Penitencial, el Gloria y Finalmente la Oración Colecta la cual es presidida por el Sacerdote y la cual expresa el carácter de la celebración.

Finalizada la Oración Colecta, nos sentamos y escuchamos la palabra de Dios en las Sagradas Escrituras. Toda Misa de Domingo cuenta con una primera Lectura, usualmente tomada del Antiguo Testamento, un Salmo Responsorial, una segunda Lectura, tomada de una de las cartas del Nuevo Testamento, luego se canta el verso del Aleluya y escuchamos la lectura de uno de los Santos Evangelios.

Después de todas las lecturas viene la homilía, terminada la homilía nos ponemos de pie y profesamos nuestra Fe diciendo el Credo. Finalmente ofrecemos nuestras oraciones como una comunidad de Fe en las Intercesiones Generales o también conocida como la Oración de los fieles dando así fin a esta primera parte de Misa.

Durante los siguientes domingos vendremos desarrollando cada uno de estos pasos de la Liturgia de la Palabra, y después de haber enfatizado un poco en cada uno de ellos, daremos inicio a la segunda parte, La Liturgia de la Eucaristía.
