APRENDE SOBRE TU FE!

El Verso del Aleluya:



Después de terminada la segunda lectura de la Misa y antes de hacer la lectura del Evangelio, decimos o cantamos una palabra que permanece en el antiguo idioma Hebreo: ¡Aleluya! Que significa “Alabado sea el Señor.”

Al iniciar cantando el verso del Aleluya, nos ponemos de pie para alabar el Señor y ofrecer una total atención a la lectura del evangelio. Usualmente el “Aleluya” es interpretado por un cantor o por el coro encargado y finalmente repetido por la congregación. Luego un corto versículo debe ser dicho o cantado y finalmente la comunidad se une nuevamente cantando el Aleluya!

La palabra Aleluya fue una parte integral en la celebración de la Pascua. Esta es utilizada una y otra vez en el libro de los salmos y de hecho podríamos decir que Jesús y sus discípulos estuvieron cantando Aleluya también en la última cena.

También en el libro del Apocalipsis se nos relata cómo las multitudes en el cielo están constantemente cantando Aleluya! Durante el tiempo de cuaresma, no decimos ni cantamos el Aleluya debido a sentido penitencial de este tiempo litúrgico.

En cuaresma utilizamos una Aclamación al evangelio antes de la lectura del Santo Evangelio, pero en la noche de la Vigilia Pascual y de ahí en adelante celebramos la resurrección de nuestro Señor con gloriosos gritos de Aleluya. Aleluya.
