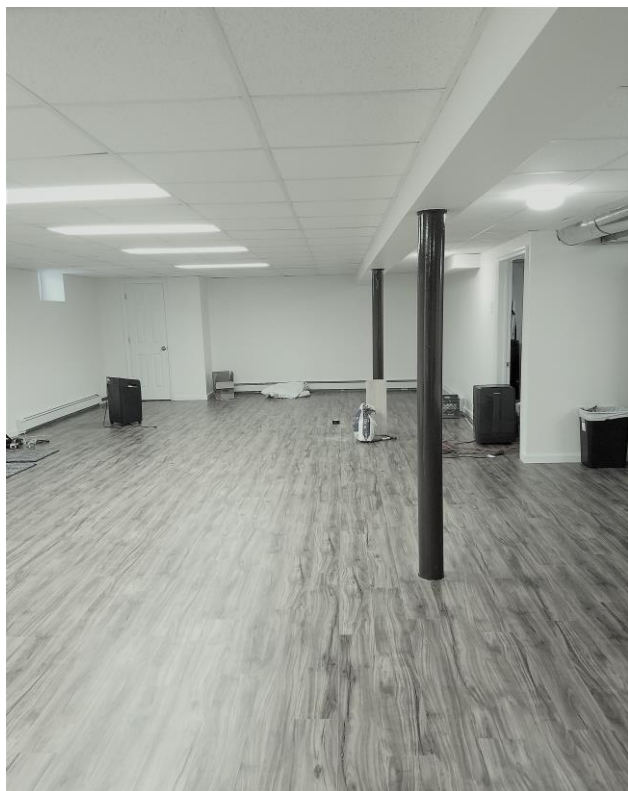

APRENDE SOBRE TU FE!

El Evangelio:

A diferencia de las dos primeras lecturas en la misa, la congregación se pone de pie para la lectura del Santo Evangelio. Esto se hace para mostrar nuestra total reverencia ante la palabra del Señor. Pero anterior a la proclamación del evangelio, la congregación hace la señal de la cruz sobre su frente, labios y pecho pidiendo que la palabra de Dios siempre este presente en nuestra mente, labios y corazón.

La palabra evangelio significa “Buena Nueva.” Los cuatro relatos del evangelio, según san Mateo, Marcos, Lucas y Juan, contienen la historia de la vida y enseñanzas de Jesús, los cuales se encuentran ubicados en el Nuevo Testamento. A diferencia de la primera y segunda lectura la cual es leída por un laico; el Evangelio es leído solo por un diacono, sacerdote u obispo dentro de la Misa. Ellos son parte del ministerio de predicación de la iglesia con total autoridad la cual les fue dada a ellos a través del Sacramento de las Ordenes Sagradas.

Terminada la proclamación del Evangelio, el Ministro, ya sea un diacono, sacerdote u obispo besa el libro en la pagina acabada de leer como reverencia a la palabra del Señor. Esta tradición ha venido siendo una práctica realizada desde las primeras décadas.



Al final de la proclamación del Evangelio, el sacerdote dirá: “Palabra del Señor” y como Jesús es presente en su palabra, la congregación se une

respondiendo “Gloria Ti Señor Jesús” luego nos sentamos y nos preparamos para escuchar la homilía.

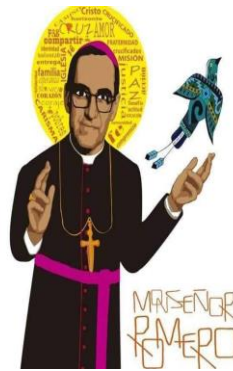
