# Felices Pascuas!

Nuevamente les saludo con un mensaje de Pascua. Aunque para muchos de ustedes suene raro o un poco atrasado este saludo Pascual, al haber transcurrido ya dos semanas después de haber celebrado el domingo de resurrección. Les recuerdo que aunque no lo creas y aunque en las tiendas ya no se estén vendiendo mas los conejitos y los huevitos de Easter, la iglesia y todos los que la conforman continuamos en este estado de gozo y regocijo por los frutos que ha traído consigo la Resurrección de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo.
