PENTECOST SUNDAY

First Reading: Acts 2:1-11

The disciples were celebrating Pentecost together when "tongues of fire appeared which parted, then came to rest on each of them." The disciples were filled with the Holy Spirit and began speaking in foreign tongues. Visitors from many different countries were amazed that each guest could hear his or her native language being spoken as the disciples proclaimed God's glory.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 12:3b-7, 12-13

Each person has received different manifestations of the same spirit to contribute to the common good of all. All members of the church have been baptized into one body because of our belief in the Holy Spirit, who was sent to us by God.

Gospel: John 20:19-23

Jesus appeared to the disciples even though they had locked the doors in fear. Jesus then showed the disciples his hands and his side; and they rejoiced at his presence. He breathed on them saying "Receive the Holy Spirit." He then gave the disciples the power to forgive others or hold them accountable for their sins.

Hoy celebramos la solemnidad de Pentecostés, la venida del Espíritu Santo sobre la Iglesia, la cual ocurre 50 días después de la celebración del domingo de Pascua. La Pascua es aquel tiempo litúrgico donde los cristianos celebramos la victoria de Jesús sobre la muerte, su ascensión al cielo y el cumplimiento de la promesa del envío del Espíritu Santo. Pentecostés es el culmen de este Tiempo Pascual y es conocido también como el cumpleaños de la Iglesia, porque es en este día en que el Espíritu Santo desciende sobre los apóstoles, quienes estaban solos y asustados después de la partida de Jesús. Y se hace realidad la promesa que Jesús les hizo “que siempre estaría con ellos”. La venida del Espíritu Santo los envolvió con una fuerza superior a la de ellos para continuar con la tarea de Jesús de construir el Reino de Dios en la tierra.

TEMOR DE DIOS: Para que vencamos el mal haciendo el bien y para que respetemos a Dios presente en todas las criaturas.

PIEDAD: Para que nos sintamos siempre hijos de Dios y vivamos como hermanos de todos los seres humanos.
