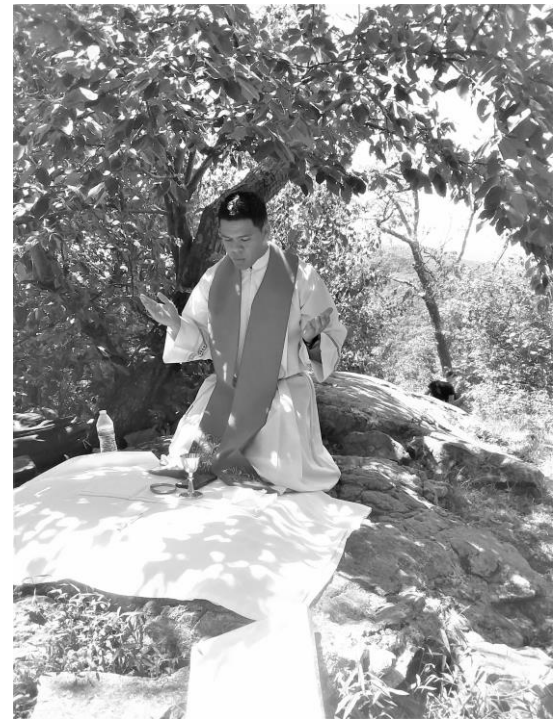

LA SAGRADA COMUNIÓN.

Puede un No católico recibir la Comunión en una iglesia Católica?

La respuesta general es un NO, con algunas excepciones, tales como para los miembros de las iglesias Ortodoxas y Orientales. Miremos por qué.

Primero, sabemos que todos son bienvenidos a la celebración de la Eucaristía. En Juan 17:21, Jesús oro diciendo: “Para que todos sean uno; como tú, oh Padre, en mí, y yo en ti, que también ellos sean uno” y esta es ciertamente la oración de la Iglesia, sin embargo, esa no es la realidad.

Como católicos, creemos que la celebración de la Eucaristía es un signo de la realidad de unidad de fe, vida y adoración de creyentes. También creemos que Jesús es realmente presente en Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma y Divinidad en la Eucaristía. Por lo tanto, ofrecer la Eucaristía a aquellos que no están en completa comunión con la iglesia sería un acto de Hipocresía en vez de unidad.

El catecismo de la Iglesia Católica en el párrafo 1400 dice esto: Comunidades Eclesiales derivadas de la Reforma y separadas de la iglesia católica, “no ha preservado la realidad propia del misterio Eucarístico en su totalidad, especialmente debido a la ausencia del sacramento de las Santa Ordenes.” Es por esta razón que, para la iglesia católica, la intercomunión eucarística con estas comunidades no es posible.

Muchas de nuestras iglesias ofrecen la oportunidad para nuestros hermanos y hermanas No- católicos recibir una bendición en lugar de la Comunión. Al final, todos debemos orar los unos por otros, y continuar orando por la completa unidad en el cuerpo de Cristo.
