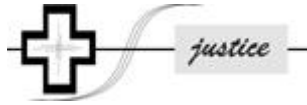

2) For families who are registering for Faith Formation *for the first time*:

- Please register with the parish first. Go to the website www.stmichaelnetcong.org, and choose the Census tab at the top.
- Follow the directions above

The following must be returned via mail OR you can drop off in the mailbox next to the office door facing Church St. *Registrations are finalized when we receive these items*

- Signed Faith Formation Covenant
- Partial payment (* If you are experiencing financial hardship, please contact us with regard to the fee)
- Baptismal certificate for new children (If your child was baptized at St. Michael we only need the full date)

End of Year Evaluations:

- If your child completed his/her end of year evaluation that was emailed in April/May, you can return it via email, drop it off in the Faith
