Dear Rev. Fr. Michael Lee,

Prayerful greetings from Sr. Jessy George, Mission Representative of the Religious Congregation of Women called "Servants of the Poor" Dinasevanasabha from India.

I sincerely express my heartfelt thanks to you for the wonderful opportunity given to us to share our mission activities to your parish and the people of God.

Let me take this privilege to brief about our congregation: Our Congregation Dinasevanasabha (Servants of the Poor) which was founded in the year 1969 in the southern part of India by a German Ursuline Nun called Mother Petra Moennigmann with the approval of the then Bishop Most Rev. Dr. Aldo Maria Patroni SJ. From the date of 2nd February 2003 onwards the Congregation has the status of Pontifical Right.

"Service of the Poor" is our charism of our Congregation. The Mission of the Congregation is to "Continue the Evangelical Mission of Christ by Rendering Services both Material and Spiritual to the Poor".

The congregation adapts the spirit of St. Francis Assisi (simple life, hard work, severe poverty, deep prayer life and Eucharistic centered life) and the missionary zeal of St. Angela Merici i.e., the upliftment of the poor and dedicated service for the Church as the mean to live the Charism.

Dinasevanasabha Today:

During the last four decades, the Congregation has grown and developed in every direction of its Charism, Spirituality, Apostolic services, Formation and Administration. In 1999 the Congregation was divided into three regions and on 1st June 2007, the regions were transformed into three Provinces and one Vice-Province. Today, the Congregation has 650 members and has 91 convents in 50 Dioceses belonging to the Latin, Syro Malabar and Syro Malankara Rites of the Catholic Church spread out in India and in abroad. We have a community at St. Henry Church, 1709 S.Flores Street, in the Archdiocese of San

Antonio, Texas and rendering services in St. Henry Parish as well as engaged in different ministries in the Archdiocese of San Antonio.

Mission Services:

The financial Support generated through this mission appeal will be used to support the works of the following:

- Pastoral Ministry, Family Apostolate
- Free Nursing Homes, orphans, disabled/ children with special needs and leprosy rehabilitation
- HIV/AIDS care and support, prison ministry
- Village medical aids and community health programme
