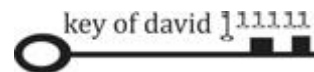

- Partial payment (\* If you are experiencing financial hardship, please contact us with regard to the fee)
- Baptismal certificate for new children (If your child was baptized at St. Michael we only need the full date)
