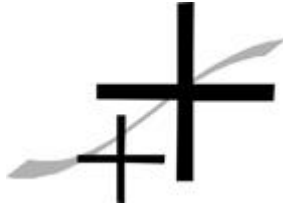

Faith Formation Registration

For families who are registering for Faith Formation for the first time:

- Please register with the parish first. Go to the website www.stmichaelnetcong.org, and choose the Census tab at the top.
- After completing the Census, follow the directions above to register your child for Faith Formation.

The following must be returned via mail OR you can drop off in the mailbox next to the office door facing Church St. *Registrations are finalized when we receive these items*

- Signed Faith Formation Covenant
- Partial payment (* If you are experiencing financial hardship, please contact us with regard to the fee)
- Baptismal certificate for new children (If your child was baptized at St. Michael we only need the full date)
