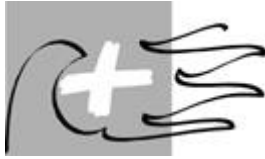

Adoration News

October is Respect Life Month

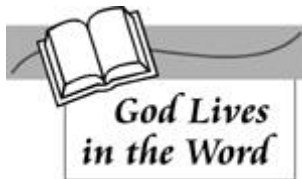
