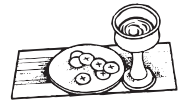

## Protect and Prevent STL

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called Prevent and Protect STL. All clergy, employees, volunteers and ministers who work with minors and vulnerable adults in the Archdiocese of St. Louis are required and asked to register in the new system before June 30, 2020. For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to the new system but you will still need to register and view the online training modules. In addition you will register for an updated background screening. No fee will be charged for the update.
