

The following Guidelines are in place for Mass, private prayer, and adoration. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation

GUIDELINES FOR MASS

- ° You must wear a face mask at all times while in the church, except during the reception of the Eucharist. Please make sure the mask covers both nose and mouth. Mask with exhaust valves are not allowed.
- ° Upon entering the church, a greeter will sanitize your hands.
- ° You may seat yourself in any open pew. The blue markers are spaced 6 feet apart and should be used to maintain social distancing between household groups.
- ° All members of a single household may walk together to receive Communion, no need to keep 6 feet apart.
- ° No formal collection will be taken up during the Mass. Instead, weekly offerings may be placed in baskets at each entrance as you enter or exit the church, mailed to the church office, or made via the online donation portal.
- ° Formation of the Communion line will be controlled by the ushers starting from the front of the church. While in line, please maintain social distancing using the markers on the carpet.
- ° Hand sanitizer is available if you would like to use it before receiving the Eucharist.
- ° After receiving Communion, all parishioners should return to their seats. To minimize the risk to other parishioners, we ask that you not depart early from the church.
- ° At the conclusion of the Mass, ushers will dismiss parishioners starting from the back of the church. Please remain in your pew until dismissed. You are welcome to remain for private prayer or to light a candle.
- ° Upon dismissal by an usher, exit from the church directly to the parking lot so that we can maintain social distancing for those exiting behind you. Please do not congregate in the narthex or on the sidewalks immediately outside the exit doors.
- ° Bathrooms will be available for urgent needs. If you choose to use the bathroom, sanitization supplies will be available. We will not have staff available to sanitize the bathrooms after each user.

GUIDELINES for PRIVATE PRAYER & ADORATION

The Church is open for Private Prayer from 7:30am to 6:00pm daily (excluding Mass and Funerals)
Eucharistic Adoration: Wednesdays, after the 8:30am Mass until 3pm.

- ° Please wear a face mask at all times while in the church. Make sure the mask covers both nose and mouth. Mask with exhaust valves are not allowed.
- ° Use the hand sanitizer to sanitize your hands before entering the sanctuary.
- ° Please use open pews only in the front center sections so that we do not have to clean the entire church at the end of the day.
- ° If you so choose, you may sanitize the pew before starting your prayer time and again before leaving. Large spray bottles and rags are provided at the main door. Spray some of the liquid onto the rag and then wipe it on the wood surface. Please do not spray the wood surface or the upholstery directly. Return the spray bottle and rag to the table when you are done.
