***Sacraments:** Grace – a share in God's divine life and friendship – comes to us most effectively through the Sacraments. When we frequently receive the Eucharist and regularly participate in the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation, the resulting grace is a key tool that strengthens us to live out our lives in God's friendship.*

***Scripture:** When facing challenges, we often "hear" the voice of a beloved parent, favorite teacher, or wise friend in our heads providing guidance from conversations past. Scripture helps us to "hear" God's voice. Through the Bible, God has equipped us with all that we need to succeed in this world and live with Him eternally in the next. It is meant to be lived.*

***Companions :** "Do not be led astray: "Bad company corrupts good morals" (1 Corinthians 15:33). Despite their best intentions, the wrong friends can lead us away from God. Choosing companions who support our faith, hold us accountable and share our love for God are important elements in our spiritual toolboxes. (*Growing in Faith*)*
